



Installation should only be undertaken by skilled persons, ensuring industry standards and 'best practice' are performed throughout all steps including handling and storage. Compliance of national, state and local codes is essential. **If unsure seek professional help.**

Inspection of all products prior to installation is essential, as the installation of products signifies an acceptance that the product meets all predetermined expectations, If, product does not meet all predetermined expectations, it should not be installed and returned as soon as possible to the place of purchase

Timber will react to atmospheric conditions where fibres swell with moisture and shrink when dry, in some instances the back face may need a sealing or painting to limit the effects of movement such as swelling, shrinkage, bowing, cupping etc. The use of paints and sealers with stain blocking agents is further recommended to avoid/limiting resin bleed. **Seek advice from all quality paint manufactures on their recommendations.**
